The six plates consist of August - Grouse Shooting, September - Partridge Shooting, October - Pheasant Shooting, November - Woodcock Shooting, December - Duck Shooting and January - Snipe Shooting. The prints are after paintings by F.C. Turner and engraved by Charles Hunt and published by J.W. Laird, Leadenhall Street, London. Each engraving in a new mount and with good colouring.

Turner was a sporting and equestrian artist from Lambeth and regular contributor to 'The Sporting Magazine', and a member of a very talented family of artists.
