The wedge is embossed 'The Champion' with the Bussey "GGB Arrow" Trade Mark', at the top of the handle 'Bussey, London'. The racket with period white gut stringing with three rows of black trebling to the top and one to the bottom. It has a pronounced leather butt cap and has a tooled leather neck collar, on the side of the handle is stamped '14'.
