The lid with plaque 'Walsall Police, Sports, August 3rd 1891, 1st Prize 220 Yards Obstacle Handicap, Won By P/C William J. Wright'. There is a paper card 'First Prize, Obstacle Race' and a photograph of P/C William J. Wright in uniform with paper cutting reading 'Death of Former Well-Known Walsall Runner, The death has occurred at Walsall in his 79th year of Mr. William J. Wright, of Walsing-ham-Street, who was a member of Walsall police force for 30 years before his retirement in 1921. Mr. Wright was a well-known runner in his early years, and won many prizes at local sports'.
