Still dressed in his hunting pinks but having exchanged his riding boots for comfortable slippers, he is accompanied by his faithful hound at his side.

A wonderful example of Aldin's ability to capture the warmth, humour and traditions of English country life, the print is presented in good, clean condition.

The Goupil Gravure was a refined photogravure process developed by Henri Rousselon of Goupil & Cie in France in 1872. Renowned for its rich, velvety blacks, subtle tonal gradations and exceptional image clarity, the process was widely used to produce high-quality art reproductions and remains highly regarded by collectors today.
