Signed Tiger Etching By Herbert Dicksee, The Destroyers.

A rather strong black and white wildlife picture of a pair of crouching Tigers in the original oak frame with mount, gold slip and title plaque. The powerful etching is by Herbert Thomas Dicksee, published September 1st 1904 by Frost & Reed, signed in pencil by the artist and is known as 'The Destroyers' with the tigers on some rocks overlooking the open grassland below. The extra information printed around the image states "Published at 8 Clare Street Bristol by Frost & Reed. Printsellers of Bristol Clifton & London, September 1st, 1904, Berlin, Stiefbold & Co. 25 MarkgrafenStrasse, Copyright registered.
