Golf Print, Sabbath Breakers, Dollman.

A fine golfing photogravure titled 'The Sabbath Breakers' after J.C Dollman, (John Charles 1851 - 1934). The picture shows John Henrie and Pat Rogie being discovered by two stern-looking clergymen whilst playing golf on the Sabbath at Leith Links in 1592, they were later prosecuted.

The artist was a member of the Royal Watercolour Society and The Royal Institute exhibiting at the Royal Academy between 1872 and 1904.

'The Sabbath Breakers, In 1592, John Henrie & Pat Rogie were prosecuted for playing Gouff the links of Leith every Sabbath during the time of the sermonses'.
