Description

Vintage Hardy fly fishing rod, the 'Halford Knockabout'.

The Hardy 'Halford Knockabout' is a split cane Palakona 2-piece rod made by Hardy's of Alwick. The rod is in excellent condition with broad crimson inter whipping, stud lock joint, alloy adjustable screw reel fitting and cork handle. It has a reversible butt spear and the alloy reel ring has Hardy's logo on it. It has the registration number H67475 dating it to 1960's. The rod is 9'4" long and is in the original Hardy's canvas bag, with label. The rod has the painted black inscription spiralling around the shaft 'the 'Halford Knockabout', 'Palakona' and 'Regd.'.

Action: Inclined stiff for dry fly, a strong rod.

Joints: 'stud' lock.

Rings: Butt and end Agate, intermediate 'Fullopen' bridge.

Tyings: Ordinary spaced broad bands, crimson silk.

Reel fittings and furnishings: Fixed 'screw-Grip' cork covered housing and 'Reversible' spear and button.

Container: Proofed partitioned cloth bag.

Length: 9ft.6ins. Weight: 7 ozs.
