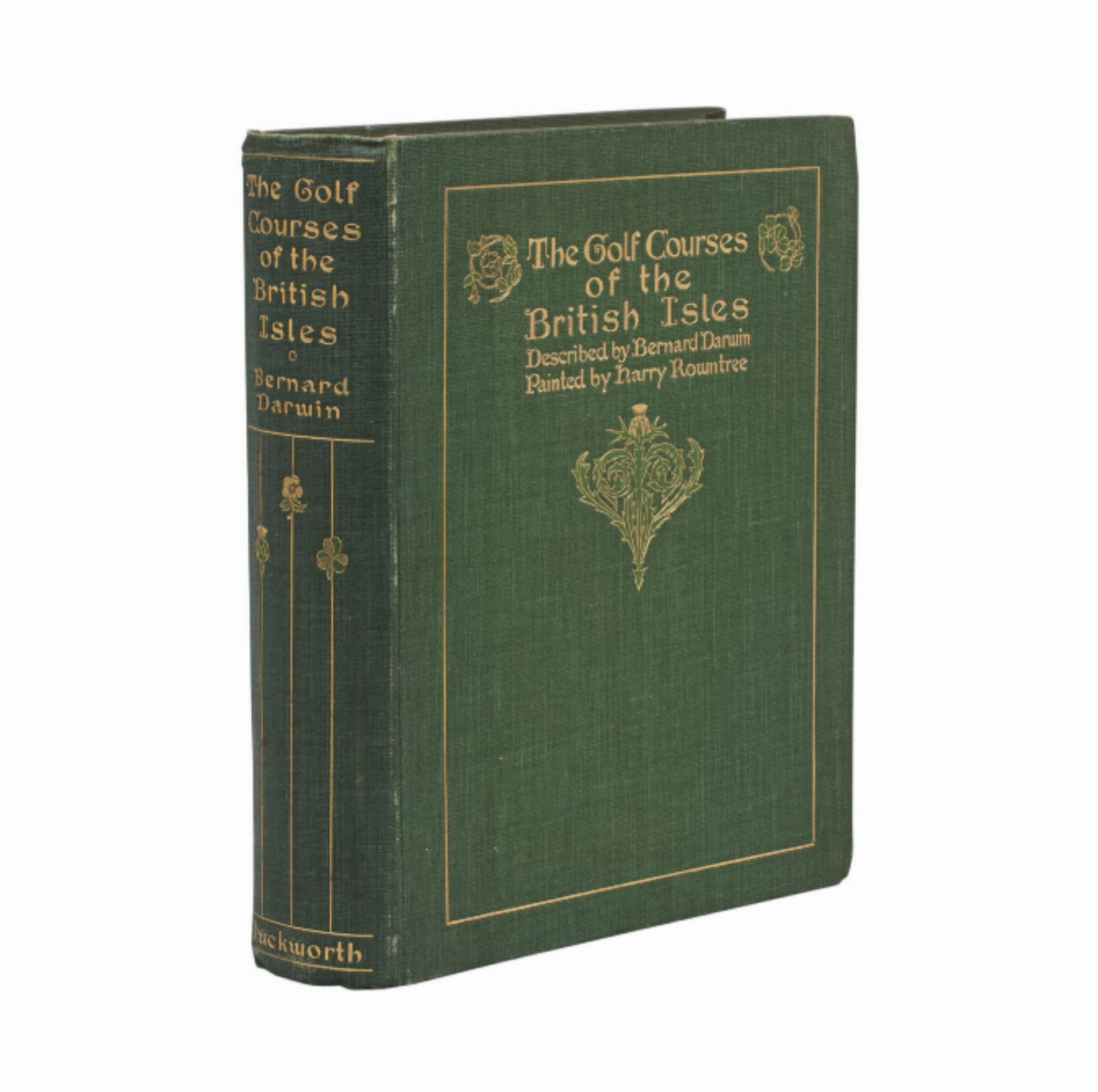

The book is with its original hard green cloth cover with embossed title and floral decoration to front and with gilt title to spine. The book has wonderful illustrations of famous holes of famous courses by Harry Rountree and great descriptions of the individual courses by Darwin that make excellent reading. Amongst the courses in the book are St. Andrews, Sunningdale, Walton Heath, Rye and Hoylake.
