Description

Scared Head Transitional Long Nose Brassie.

An elegant scared head transitional long nose golf club by Tom Morris of St Andrews. This great looking club is also known as a Brassie, it has a black stained club head with full brass sole plate, lead weight to the rear and the traditional horn slip along the leading edge of the sole, the polished head is stamped 'T. Morris'. The hickory shaft with polished leather grip.

This is a very nice example of a scared head golf club from the 1890's in excellent condition.

Approximate head size:-

a = 7 cm

b = 3 cm

c = 4.7 cm

The early clubs are made with a hickory shaft glued to the head by means of a splice or scare joint. This joint is then further strengthened by whipping with a pitched thread. All beautifully hand made by craftsmen of the time.
