Beautifully composed and full of movement, these engaging sporting scenes showcase Aldin's remarkable ability to capture the character and energy of horses in action. Set against simple, uncluttered backgrounds, the figures and horses become the focal point of each composition, allowing the artist's exceptional draughtsmanship and natural gift for storytelling to shine through.

Cecil Aldin remains one of Britain's most admired sporting artists and illustrators, renowned for his affectionate depictions of horses, dogs, country life, and traditional sporting pursuits. His work continues to be celebrated for its warmth, humour, and keen observation of both animal and human character, qualities that are clearly evident in these delightful friezes.

Published in 1903 by Lawrence & Bullen, this attractive pair of early twentieth-century chromolithographs is presented in their original glazed oak frames, enhancing both their decorative appeal and collector interest.
