Vintage Snaffles First World War Print, Wipers.

A good Snaffles WWI military print entitled 'Wipers'. The main center colour-piece hand coloured lithograph is mounted onto the printed remarque board. The Snaffles lithograph shows a wounded soldier standing in front of the burnt Cloth Hall of Ypres with a German 'pickelhaube' impaled on his bayonet. In the bottom margin is a remarque depicting the dead lying in the mud. This Charles "Snaffles" Johnson Payne (1884-1967) framed picture is in excellent condition with the Snaffles blindstamp (a bridle bit) in the bottom right hand corner.
