Vintage Signed Stuart SurrIDGE Cricket Bat, 1957 West Indies Tour.

A good autographed willow cricket bat stamped on the face 'County Driver' with the maker's name: Stuart SurrIDGE & Co. Ltd, London, England, with the Wellington trade mark on the shoulders of the bat. The bat has a Patent reinforced toe. We were told this cricket bat was won by a London schoolboy in a raffle at Cheltenham College grounds during Cheltenham Cricket Week. The face of the blade with 28 original pen signatures - West Indies & England. The rear of the bat with signatures from the 'Gentlemen', 'Players', Somerset and Gloucestershire cricket teams.

The players listed below played in the 1957 West Indies Tour, their autographs / signature could well be on this bat.
