There is a gentleman behind coming down the steps with a smirk on his face whilst holding a pipe and delivers the print's punchline, "Having No Spade, Partner?". This is a classic example of British dry humour, reflecting the gentle mockery and etiquette quirks that made golf humour so enduring in British culture.
