Signed Artist's Proof - Grouse Shooting by Douglas Adams.

A superb shooting photogravure taken from the original painting by celebrated British artist Douglas Adams (1853-1920). This Artist's Proof is signed in pencil by the artist and bears the 'Print Sellers Association' blind stamp, confirming its authenticity and provenance.

The artwork, titled Grouse Shooting, vividly captures the spirit of the British shooting season. Set against a windswept moorland landscape, it portrays two sportsmen at the height of action - one taking aim from behind a low stone wall while the other reloads, ready for the next flush of grouse. Adams' masterful use of light and composition lends the scene both atmosphere and vitality, making it a classic example of late 19th-century sporting art.
